Your Application Timeline



1

- 18-24 Months Before**
- Research schools
 - Register and prepare for entrance exams
 - Set up an advising session with an EducationUSA adviser



2

- 12-18 Months Before**
- Narrow down your list of schools
 - Research requirements for each school
 - Prepare for and take entrance exams



3

- 10-12 Months Before**
- Speak with teachers and counselors to get letters of recommendation
 - Request transcripts
 - Write application essays

4

- 8-10 Months Before**
- Retake exams, if needed
 - Complete and submit application



5

- 3-5 Months Before**
- Select the school you'll attend
 - Apply for your student visa
 - Attend EducationUSA Pre-Departure Orientation



6

- 0-2 Months Before**
- Finalize housing
 - Pack your bags
 - Attend orientation on campus

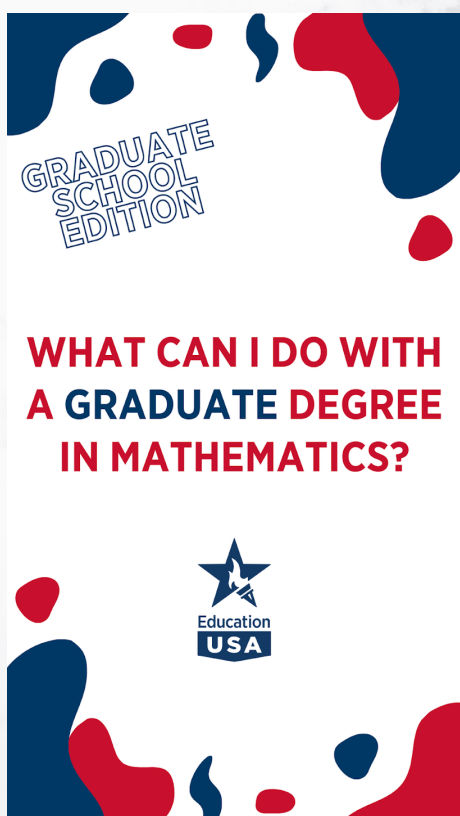
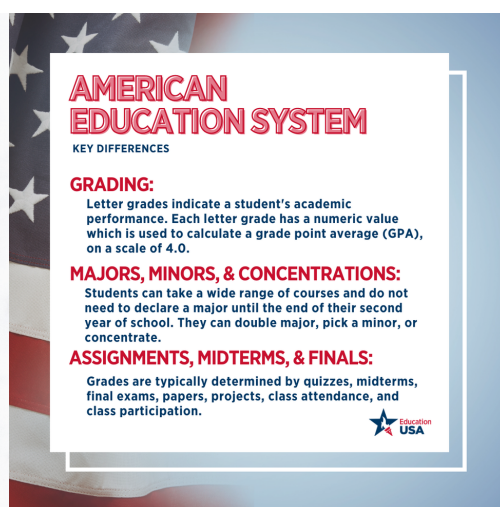
SUNY Stony Brook is recognizing first-year international students. Awardees of their #YouAreWelcomeHere scholarship will have 50% of their tuition covered.
